Integrated Ocean Management

• Why attend:

About 500,000 West Africans live on the coasts and are affected by constant floods every year. 50% of regional fisheries related jobs are expected to be lost by 2050 if coasts continue to decline. There is a strong need to adopt an Integrated Ocean Management approach that can save the ecosystems. This session will therefore set the basis on how to ensure sustainable use of natural resources and ecosystem

services, including those of freshwater ecosystems and promote and maintain ecosystem resiliency.

How can the implementation of adaptive tools on Integrated Ocean Management lead to regional policy development?

• Description:

The Convention for Cooperation in the Protection and Development of the Marine and Coastal Environment of West and Central Africa provides a general legal framework for all marine-related programmes in West, Central and Southern Africa. The Abidjan Convention through its protocol on Integrated Coastal Zone Management is encouraging parties to implement the protocol as an instrument within the purview of laws governing their coastal zone.

The session will focus on different presentations, feedback on the implementation of projects dealing with Integrated Ocean Management, benefits and lessons learned.
